Drones

It was reported over the weekend that a member of the public on Midsummer Common was flying a drone over our development. We have experienced Drones in the past.

Current advice is that in the UK, drone laws are governed by the <u>Civil Aviation Authority (CAA)</u>, and require registration and adherence to specific operational rules. Drones weighing 250g or more, or those with a camera, must be registered with the CAA. Operators also need to obtain an Operator ID. Flying drones requires keeping them within visual line of sight (VLOS), not exceeding 400 feet (120 meters) in altitude, and avoiding crowds and restricted airspace.

The laws on flying drones are part of the Air Navigation Order 2016. In the law a drone is called an Unmanned Aircraft (UA).

So, consumer drones, like the one spotted over the weekend, must be flown no higher than 120 metres and be kept at <u>least 50 metres</u> away from people and private property, and 150 metres away from congested areas.

It is illegal to fly drones near airports or airfields, so our proximity to Cambridge Airport might affect our particular situation.
